Criteria:

- GPA of 3.0 or greater

The foundation gives preference in awarding this scholarship to residence of Talladega, Tallapoosa, Coosa, Elmore, and Clay Counties in Alabama.

Applicant must submit the following to be included in the selection process:

- *Completed Application**
- *Copy of acceptance letter into an accredited nursing, pharmacy or allied health school**
- *Brief autobiography, including why you have chosen this career path**
- *Copy of study program with cost analysis**
- *Transcript from previous college studies with a GPA of 3.0 or greater**
- *Two letters of reference; one professional and one personal**

Qualified applicants will be notified of interview date.**
