

## **1557 Non-Discrimination Regulation Policy**

Please note: pursuant to decisions by various district courts regarding the 2024 Final Rule implementing Section 1557, entitled Nondiscrimination in Health Programs and Activities, 89 Fed. Reg. 37,522 (May 6, 2024) ("2024 Final Rule"), certain provisions regarding gender identity are stayed nationwide.
